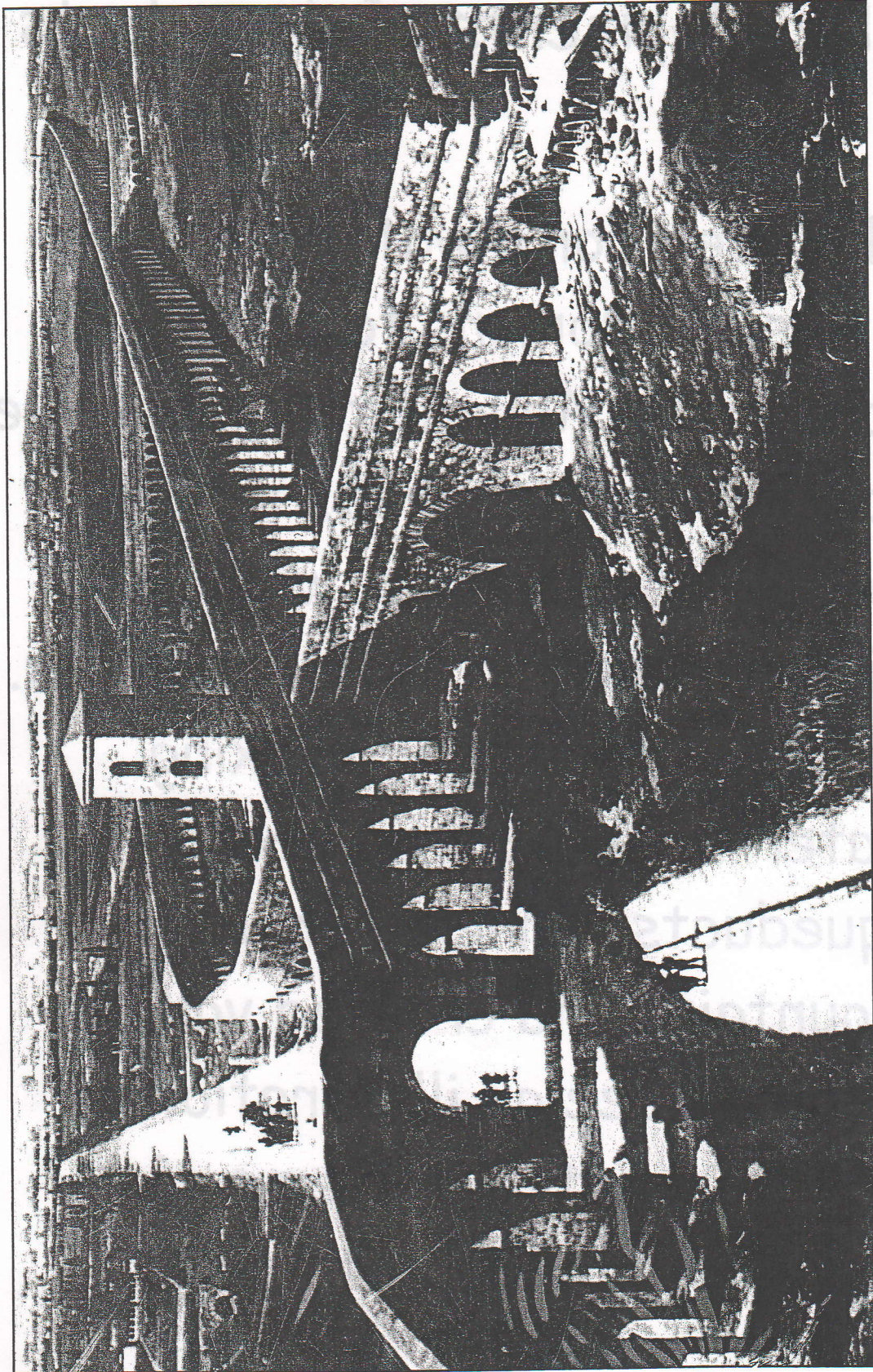


# Development of Aqueducts
