Standards for Evaluating Your Work

EXCELLENT

- The campaign poster and election material met all of the project requirements.
- The poster was informative, interesting, and attractive.
- The poster was well written and included no spelling errors.
- All group members participated in viewing promotional posters and casting ballots in the election.

GOOD

- The campaign poster and election material met most of the project requirements.
- The poster was mostly informative, interesting, and neat.
- The poster was adequately written and included few spelling errors.
- Most group members participated in viewing promotional posters and casting ballots in the election.

ACCEPTABLE

- The campaign poster and election material met some of the project requirements.
- The poster was fairly informative, interesting, and neat.
- The poster included some spelling errors.
- Some group members participated in viewing promotional posters and casting ballots in the election.

UNACCEPTABLE

- The campaign poster and election material failed to meet the project requirements.
- The poster was not informative, interesting, or neat.
- The poster was poorly written and included many spelling errors.
- Few group members participated in viewing promotional posters and casting ballots in the election.
